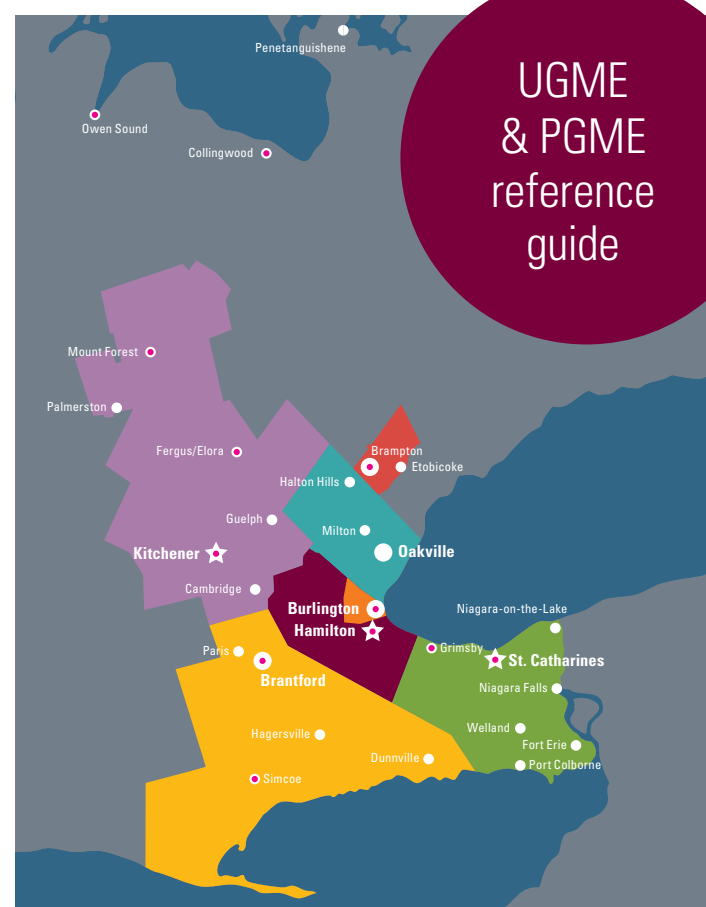

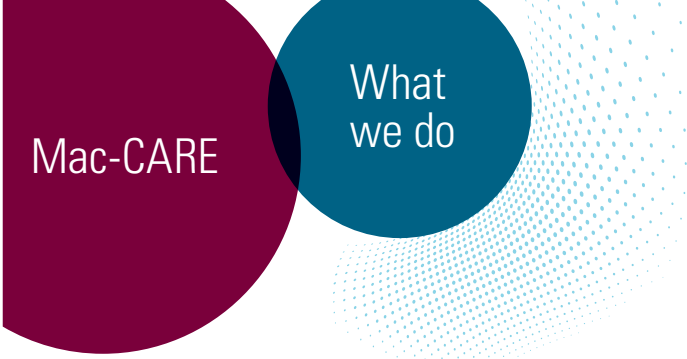

## 1 Step one: Learner rotation location eligibility

\*Exception for Postgraduate Royal College Specialty (RCPSC) Accommodation and/or Travel reimbursement is provided for Waterloo Regional Campus and Niagara Regional Campus CaRMs – matched Postgraduate Royal College specialty (RCPSC) residents who must return to Hamilton for specialty rotations necessary for accreditation and that are not available in the regional campuses.

## 2 Step two: Learner funding criteria

Funding is available to all McMaster eligible learners whose rotations are one month/block (a minimum of 4 consecutive weeks in the same community), located in an eligible location (noted in Step 1), and whose registered MedSIS current living address is not located within 35 kms of rotation site. As referenced in the *Mac-CARE Travel & Housing Policy* and online learner eligibility tool website: [finmcare.mcmaster.ca](http://finmcare.mcmaster.ca) **\$800.00** for housing **OR \$450** for commuting per month/block

## 3 Step three: Preceptor funding

Funding is available to all eligible clinical preceptors who teach McMaster MOHLTC funded clerks & residents in ALL McMaster campus regions (Niagara Regional Campus, Waterloo Regional Campus, Grand Erie Six Nations Clinical Education Campus, Burlington Clinical Education Campus, Halton Clinical Education Campus and the Osler Clinical Education Campus): **\$250.00/week**, minimum one consecutive week

## 4 Step four: Submitting placement request

UGME placements are facilitated by MedSIS. PGME core & elective requests are facilitated by the PGME Placement Application. All required forms will be provided with instructions by the regional campus coordinators and can be found on the Mac-CARE website: [mac-care.ca](http://mac-care.ca)

## 5 Step five: Register for funding

Mac-CARE travel and housing registration and reimbursement process is facilitated online. Visit [finmcare.mcmaster.ca](http://finmcare.mcmaster.ca), go to **registration**, and login with your MacID.

All registrations for Mac-CARE funding must be submitted on or before the start date of rotation. Effective July 1, 2019, claims that are submitted after the rotation start date **WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.**
